Gifts-in-Kind

A gift-in-kind is an item such as equipment, software, or tools that a donor gives to the Hambidge Center without fee or charge.

We're grateful to receive gifts-in-kind that support our mission and programs. We ensure these gifts are properly accounted for and acknowledged and, as such, require in-take information about each proposed gift.

The Hambidge Center wants to also ensure we can put your gift-in-kind to use at our facilities or with staff. Each gift is evaluated and approved accordingly. We unfortunately cannot accept items the Hambidge Center doesn't currently have immediate need for.

Once accepted, the donated items become the property of the Hambidge Center, which retains the right to use or dispose of the gift-in-kind as we need, unless another arrangement has been made with the donor.

All in-kind gifts will receive written acknowledgment and receipt of the gift and can be used for tax-deductible purposes, as according to law.
